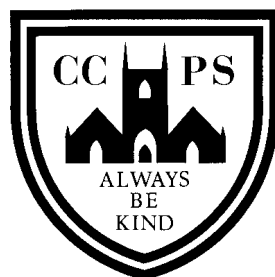

		Equipment will be in place for the foreseeable future for EYFS and KS1 classes. Indicator 1
Equipment	£2391	Including: playground equipment such basketball hoops, rebound nets, foam balls for increased activity at lunchtimes. Replacing old netballs, hockey sticks and other generic PE equipment. Purchasing badminton equipment to increase the range of sports available to children. Increased equipment will allow maximum participation and engagement from all children during lessons. Storage equipment for equipment to ensure it is kept in good condition and easily accessible for all. PE cupboard stock should now last for several years. All indicators
Skipping Workshop (Booked for September 2021)	£375	To engage and inspire children in the sport of skipping, providing physical activity and games for lunchtimes. Intent is for this to then be seen in action during playtimes etc. Older children to master, inspire and help younger children. Indicator 1 & 4
Dance workshop for (Booked for October 2021)	£490	To engage and inspire children in dance and different variations of dance (African). Indicator 1 & 4
Get Set for PE - 3 year membership	£1375	A new, sport specific scheme of work for the whole school. This will allow teachers to confidently deliver lessons in a wider range of sports and keep the children engaged through well structured lessons. Elements of competition are built into the scheme which also provides activities for lunch times and after school clubs. All indicators
