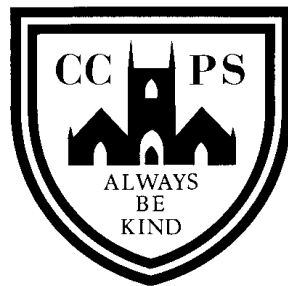

## **Home-School Agreement**

- deal promptly with any anxieties raised by parents;
- encourage the child to do his/her best at all times;
- encourage the child to respect other children and adults, and to look after the school environment;
- inform parents about what the teachers aim to teach the children each term, and discuss the child's progress with parents at regular meetings during the school year and issue written school reports;
- contact parents if there is a problem with attendance or punctuality;
- let parents know about any concerns or problems which affect their child's work or behaviour;
- set, mark and monitor homework;
- keep parents informed about school activities through the school website and regular letters home.

## *Parents/Carers*

### **I / We shall do our best to:**

- make sure that my / our child arrives at school on time – at 8.40 a.m. and is collected promptly at the end of the school day;
- make sure that my / our child attends regularly, and contact school on the first day of any absence before 9.15 a.m.;
- make sure that the school has up-to-date emergency contact numbers;
- attend regular parents' meetings to discuss my / our child's progress;
- support the school in encouraging my / our child to behave well and make the school aware of any concerns or problems which might affect his / her work or behaviour;
- will support the school's behaviour and anti-bullying policies (which can be viewed on the school website).
- Show consideration and respect for all members of the school community when using social networking sites, particularly in the sharing of photography and video footage (see E-safety policy).
- support my / our child in homework, reading and other opportunities for home learning, and ensure that work is returned on the correct date;
- make sure that my / our child has the correct equipment for school each day;
- read information sent home from school or posted on the website in the form of notices, newsletters, teachers' letters, etc. and reply to school correspondence;
- ensure that my / our child wears labelled school uniform and observes dress and jewellery guidelines.

### **I shall do my best to:**

- work hard, listen carefully to instructions and complete my classwork and homework as well as I can;

- wear the school uniform and be tidy in appearance;
- walk quietly around the school buildings;
- take letters home and deliver them to my parent / carer and return the replies;
- have the correct equipment / kit in school for my lessons and bring my homework back on time.
- talk to my teacher if I am unhappy or need help.
- Follow the school’s E-safety rules.
