

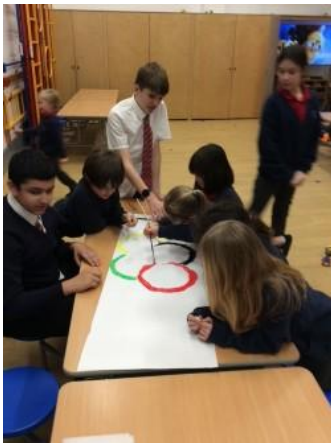
# KidZone Newsletter
