habitat	A place where a plant or animal lives.
survival	How a living thing stays alive.
adaptation	How living things change to suit their environment in order to survive
living	A living thing is alive. It must do certain things to stay alive. (MRS GREN helps us remember)
dead	A dead thing was once alive but is no longer living.
never alive	A thing that was never alive - they do not need air, water or food.
