## Year 2 Design and Technology – Bread-making project

Dear parents and carers,

As part of our Design and Technology curriculum, we always have a Food Technology project and in Year 2 it is bread-making! It makes sense to complete this in the first few weeks of this term as we learn about the Great Fire of London and the fire starting in the bakery on Pudding Lane.

Children will taste a variety of breads, research some recipes, look at healthy choices and design their own loaf of bread before measuring, creating, baking and tasting their own loaves of bread.

We will use a recipe using yeast, strong white bread flour, wholemeal flour, salt and water. The children will also be able to choose from other ingredients such as olives, seeds, grains, oats, raisins etc.

If your child has any recent changes to their diet or has new food allergies, please let me know as soon as possible.

Updated contact/health forms will be sent out in these first few days of term however we would like to start this project as soon as possible as we get to know each other this first week of term.

In order to cover the cost of this activity, we are asking for a **voluntary contribution of £2.00**. Your contribution is entirely voluntary and your child would not be denied taking part just because you were unable to make a payment. However, we will not be able to proceed with the activity unless there are sufficient voluntary contributions for it to be financed.
