Captain Robert Falcon Scott was an English polar explorer. He kept a diary of his voyages.



Edward Wilson was a polar explorer, scientist and artist who was born in Cheltenham.



Explorer Someone who travels to places about which very little is known, in order to discover what is there.

Expedition A journey made by a group of explorers.

Captain The person in charge of a ship.

Voyage A long journey on a ship.

Continent A very large area of land, such as Africa or Asia, that is made of several countries.

Antarctica A continent at the bottom of the Earth that includes areas around the South Pole. It is an area of land, covered in ice.

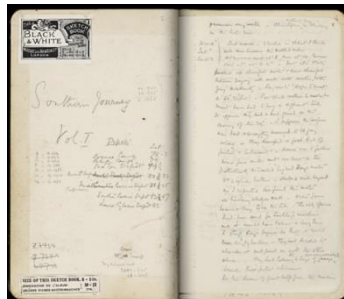
