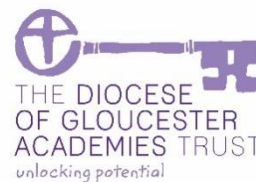

## Topics

Times Tables - A reminder that children will be working hard in school in preparation for their Multiplication Times Table Check. Their assigned TTRS sessions are designed to support them with their recall and confidence ahead of the Year 4 Multiplication

Check in the summer. Do please help your child with this at home by practising their times tables in other ways too and supporting their recall of these important facts.
