## Homework

**Spellings** - Please continue to practise the spellings that are sent home on a Monday in readiness for Friday's spelling quiz.

**Reading** – Children all have their own Oxford Reading Buddy log in recorded in their reading diary. They are enjoying reading these online books and completing the quizzes which then tracks their comprehension skills. Please do continue to hear them read aloud and encourage them to answer questions independently, which will help refine their retrieval skills. Whether it is these online books or a paper book you are sharing, your child is expected to read at least 4 times per week as part of their homework. Please record when they have read in their reading diaries.

**Times Tables** – A reminder that your child will be sitting the online Year 4 Multiplication Check this term. Do please do as much practice as possible at home to boost their confidence levels and assist their fast recall of these facts. As mentioned at parents' evenings, this website provides a very close simulation to the test. [MTC - Multiplication Tables Check - URBrainy.com](#) It will provide you with a good insight into your child's ability when answering the 6 second questions. It also provides a score and highlights the questions/ times tables facts they need to consolidate.

Children are still expected to complete 4 sessions of Times Tables Rockstars each week, outside of school hours. This is to support them with their times tables recall and confidence ahead of the Year 4 Multiplication Check as discussed. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact us.
