

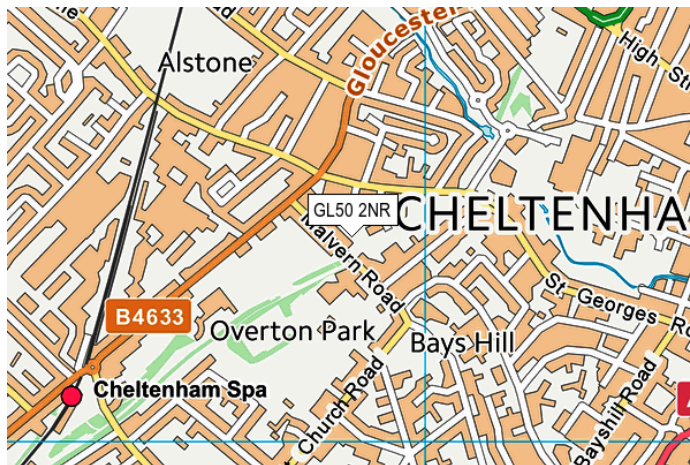


# Year 1 Geography Knowledge organiser
