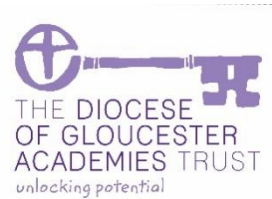

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope everyone had a lovely half-term break. This term, I have planned lots of exciting learning for our new enquiry project **“How does the geography of Kampong Ayer compare to the geography of where I live?”** In this Geography led theme, we will be comparing and contrasting life in Cheltenham with life in Kampong Ayer, Brunei. Our science work will look at Living things and their Habitats. We have an upcoming visit **to the Science Festival tomorrow Tuesday 2nd June. Please ensure permissions and payments have been made today.** Knowledge organisers for science and geography are attached to use at home for retrieval practice. Our class webpage contains more information and photographs of our learning are updated weekly. I have noticed many children are not bringing water bottles and raincoats to school so please ensure these things are packed with the other daily items in the list below.

Areas of learning for Term 6:

English – Narrative, Information text, Poetry
Maths – Time, Statistics, Position and Direction
Science – Living Things and their Habitats
PE – Net and Wall Games, Athletics
Computing – Programming, Typing skills, e-Safety, Research

Geography – Kampong Ayer, Brunei
DT – Textiles, sewing felt decorations
PSHE – Changing Me and Relationships and Sex Education
RE – How can someone’s worldview affect the choices they make?
Music – Reflect, Rewind and Replay

Remember these items everyday:

Water bottle	Light waterproof coat with hood	Reading books and reading diaries
PE Kits	Sunhat	Suncream if needed and will be applied by your child

Homework

- Reading remains a priority in Year 2 with children being listened to at least 4 times a week at home by parents. Please record each time your child is listened to. Children will continue to borrow school library books. Thank you for always returning them; we will continue to visit the library on Thursdays.
- NumBots is available for your child to access for Maths homework. Their username/pin is inside their reading diary. Pupils can continue using TimesTablesRockStars using the same log in details as NumBots. Remember by the end of Year 2 children need to learn their 2, 5 and 10 x tables and related division facts.
- Oxford Reading Buddy log in details should be in your child’s reading diary and I thoroughly recommend this resource to supplement your child’s reading as it has quizzes that monitor their progress in reading skills.
- Spellings will continue to be sent home weekly. Return the practice sheets to earn house points.
- Year 2 pupils need to read the time on an analogue clock to 5-minute intervals and we would appreciate your help in practising this at home.

Top tip! We write TOP at the top of the clock so they can see T if for “to,” O is for “o’clock” and P is for “past.” Children only need to know the 12-hour clock at this age. We have been practising o’clock/half past, quarter to/past since September as these are Y1 objectives but now need to know 5-minute intervals e.g. 5 past 4, 20 to 6 etc.
