The first will be a trip to the Cheltenham Literature Festival on **Wednesday 14th October**. We will walk to the "The Forum" in Montpellier Gardens for our session with the author Jenny McLachlan at 10:30am. Following this, we will head to the "Story Shack" for a story telling experience at 12pm. Hopefully the weather will be good enough for us to enjoy a picnic lunch afterwards. We will return to school for lunch so a packed lunch for the trip is not required. The cost of this trip will be **£3 per child.**

The final trip will be to Cineworld to watch a film as part of the "Into Film Festival" on **Thursday 19th November at 10am**. The film festival aims to "help educators bring learning to life for 5-19-year-olds across the UK by inspiring young people to watch, understand and make films in new and creative ways." This is a free event so payment is not required.
