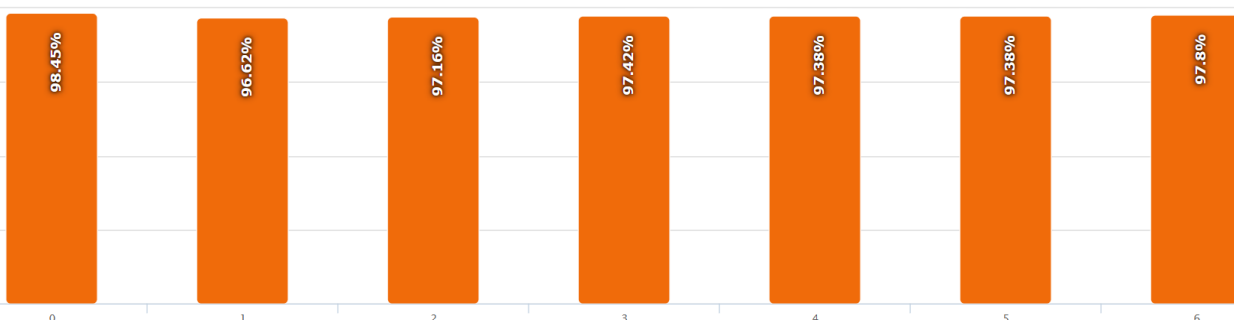


Attendance- Term 1
