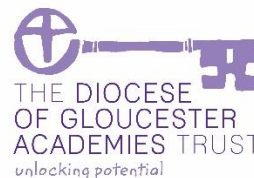

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach our upcoming residential visit to Liddington, we would like to share some final arrangements and reminders to help the departure and return run smoothly.

Drop-off arrangements

- On Monday morning, children should be dropped off on the playground at the usual time.
- **Please ensure all belongings are clearly labelled.**
- Mrs Burton, Miss Guy & Mr Hofman will be at the Y4 hall door. Please help your child bring in their labelled luggage and bedding into the hall. Suitcases will be stored in the school hall and their small rucksacks for the coach will go up to class with them, when Mrs Burton takes the class up.
- Please give any NAMED medication/NAMED travel sickness tablets to Mr Hofman.
- Please give NAMED purse or wallet with their spending money of up to £10 to Miss Guy.
- Mrs Burton will answer any last-minute questions/ final farewell to parents before taking children up to class.
- Children attending breakfast club to take their luggage there and give any NAMED medication/NAMED money to Kidzone staff to be passed on to the Y4 staff.
- The coach will be leaving promptly at 10:30am.

Kit list/ packing

- Please take time to check the kit list carefully, which is attached in the PPT from the Parents' Evening earlier in the year.
- We will be visiting the gift shop this year. No more than £10 please. Coins are easier as the shop gets really busy- we will have an allocated time. Please hand money in a named purse/ wallet to Miss Guy at drop off on Monday.
- Children can have their small backpack for the coach with water bottle/ book or pad and pen for the coach/ sun hat and sun cream (Although the forecast is good the weather can invariably be unpredictable so please pack accordingly- sunscreen and a hooded coat).

Return arrangements

- We will be leaving Liddington at approximately 1:30pm on Wednesday.
- We expect to arrive back at school at around 2:40pm, depending on traffic.
- Collection will be from the playground. We will notify you via usual school communication channels if there are any significant delays.

We hope to upload photos of the residential on our new website class page. Obviously, the first night we prioritise helping and settling children with their bedtime routine, so photos may be uploaded when staff have chance on Tuesday evening.
